

Terms & Conditions

1. Number of Entries:

Schools -The maximum amount of entries permitted per school is 20.

Individuals - An individual can enter the competition with a maximum of 3 entries.

2. How to Enter: The logo can be submitted in digital format or as an illustration on an A3 poster.

- Poster - all personal details of the student must be included on the reverse side of the poster.
- Digital Format- please submit Jpeg files ONLY and no file can be bigger than 5MB.

3. Personal Details: All competition entries must include the following information either printed clearly on the reverse of each poster for A3 illustrations, or included in an accompanying email for Jpegs:

a. Student's Name; b. Class/Year/Course; c. Age (secondary school only); d. Name of School/Name of Third Level Institution.

4. Postal Address: Entries should be submitted by post to the following address: *Bike Week Logo Competition, FAO Derek O'Neill, Department of Transport, Tourism and Sport, Leeson Lane, D2.*

Please ensure your poster is packaged appropriately.

5. Email Address for entries: SustainableTransport@DTTAS.ie Please put "Bike Week Logo Competition" in the subject line of the e-mail.

6. School's Details: For school entries; please include contact details for the Green-Schools Coordinator (name, phone number and email address) for correspondence purposes.

7. Notification: Competition winners will be notified within 30 days of the close of the competition by either post /telephone/email.

8. Judging: An independent panel of judges will select the winning entries. The judges' decision is final. No correspondence relating to the competition will be entered into.

9. Returns: The Department of Transport, Tourism and Sport is unable to return any entries.

10. Publicity: Winners may be asked to take part in competition publicity including being photographed by the media.

11. By entering this competition, you acknowledge that your entry (including name and school/ campus) may be shown on Department of Transport, Tourism and Sport websites/ social media, at DTTAS events/ seminars and other publications/ events associated with the Department of Transport, Tourism and Sport and Bike Week.

12. Eligibility: The competition is open to all registered Green-Schools who are working on, or have completed, the Travel theme as well as Third Level Institutions that are taking part in the Smarter Travel Campus Programme.
