Age Group: Junior and Senior Primary – to do supervised by a responsible adult

The following activity is mostly targeted at junior and senior infants with adult supervision but can be enjoyed by older kids too.

It is incredible the amount of stuff that you can do with something as simple as a paper bag and some paint; the only limit is your imagination! To stay on the “marine theme” why not attempt to create some colourful sea creatures? Let’s do a jellyfish!

What do you need:

- Paper bag
- Paint
- Paint brushes
- A paper plate or a bowl to mix the paint
- Glue
- Googly eyes (optional)
- Scissors (to use under adult supervision)

*Even better if you have zigzag scissors to cut in a wavy way!



What do you do then?

- 1- Start by choosing your paint and – if you want - mixing some colours on the paper plate/bowl.
- 2- Paint the paper bag.
- 3- Let it dry.
- 4- Cut the “open side” of the paper bag in strips, to make tentacles.



- 5- Add glue and stick on the googly eyes, alternatively just draw some eyes with a black marker.
- 6- Voila!
