Marine Themed Arts and Crafts!

Age Group: Junior and Senior Primary – to do supervised by a responsible adult

What better way of spending time than using some recycled material to do some art and crafts?

The following activities are mostly targeted at junior and senior infants with adult supervision but can be enjoyed by older kids too.

It's incredible the amount of stuff that you can do with something as simple as the inside of a toilet paper roll and some paint; the only limit is your imagination!

To stay on the "marine theme" why not attempt to create some colourful sea creatures? Let try make an octopus!

What material do you need:

- Paper rolls (inside core of toilet paper or paper towel rolls)
- Scissors – (to use under adult supervision)
- Small bowl for paint
- Paint
- Paint brushes
- A plastic lid or something to use as a plate to paint and let dry
- Glue
- Googly eyes (optional)
- Black marker

What do you need to do?

- 1- Choosing one side of the toilette paper roll start cutting vertically stripes about 1/3 length of the tube, these will be the tentacles
- 2- Curl-up the tentacles with your fingers



3- Paint the outside of your octopus, let dry



4- Paint the inside of your octopus, let dry

5- Optionally you can make some extra decorations on the inside and / or outside of the tentacles

6- Draw the eyes or place the google eyes and voila!
