Age Group: Junior and Senior Primary – to do supervised by a responsible adult

The following activity is mostly targeted at junior and senior infants with adult supervision but can be enjoyed by older kids too.

It is incredible the amount of stuff that you can do with something as simple as a paper cup and some paint; the only limit is your imagination! To stay on the “marine theme” why not attempt to create some colourful sea creatures? Let’s do a Crab!

What do you need:

- Paper cup
- Cardboard or paper-sheet
- Paint
- Paint brushes
- Glue
- Googly eyes (optional)
- Black marker
- Scissors (to use under adult supervision)

What do you do then?

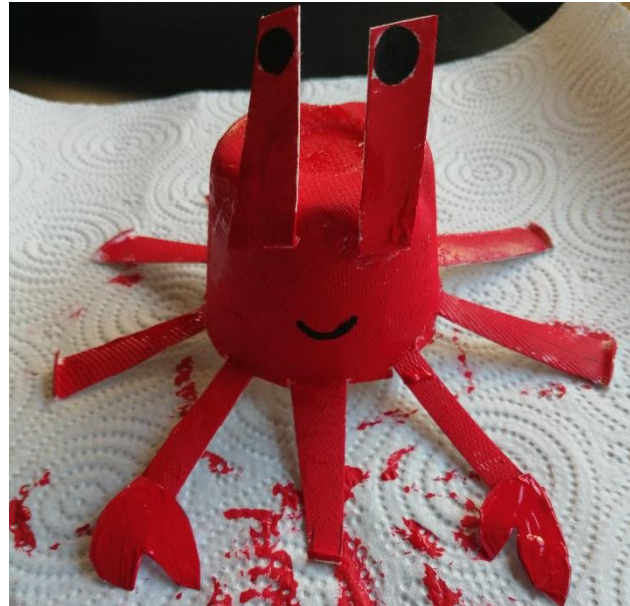
- 1- Start out by drawing and cutting eight legs on the paper cup
- 2- Flatten out the legs
- 3- Paint both sides of the paper cup red and let dry



- 4- Draw two eyes on some red cardboard and cut them out



- 5- Glue the googly eyes onto the red cardboard eyes or use the black marker to draw the eyes
- 6- Draw two pincers on some red cardboard and cut them out
- 7- Glue the pincers onto the front two legs of the crab
- 8- Draw a black mouth underneath the eyes
- 9- Voila!
