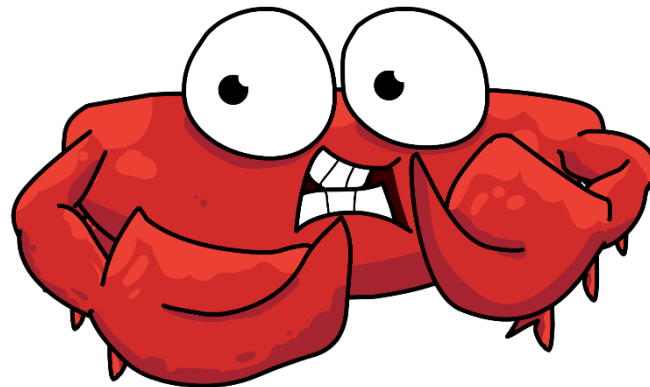


Red Crabs Quiz Sheet
