## Draw Along Octopus

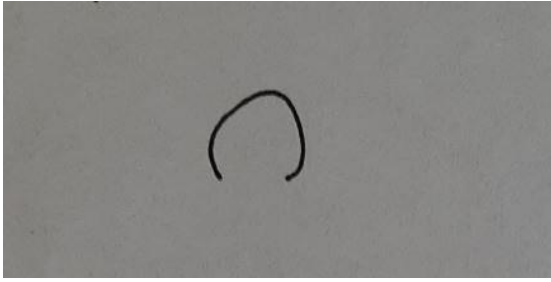
### What material do you need:

- If using paint, you will need brushes, water and newspaper (to stop the mess)

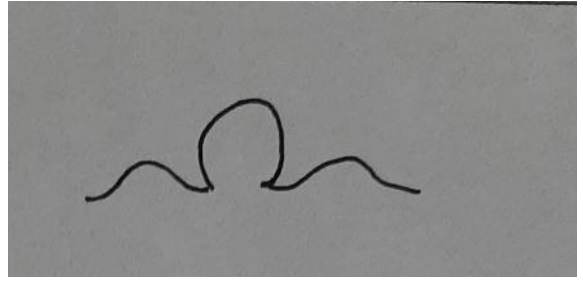


### What do you do then?

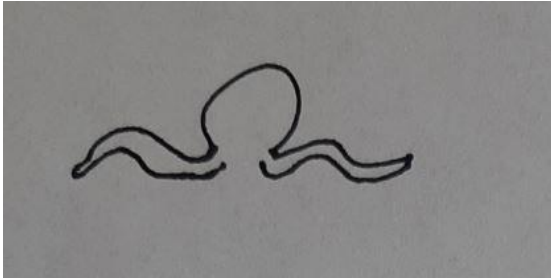
- Simple draw along with the pictures below
- Remember to use the full page



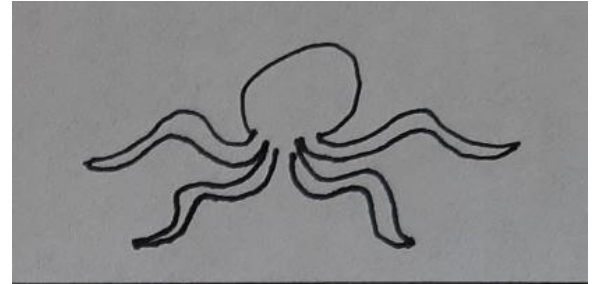
To start our Octopus we draw a semi circle



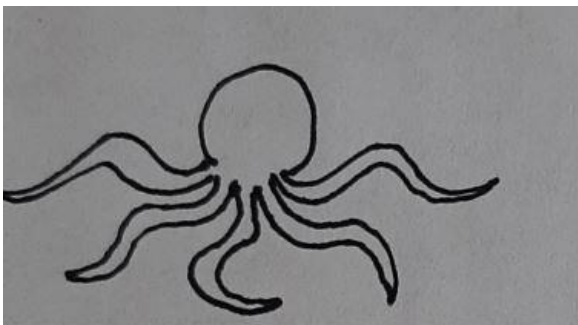
From the bottom of the semi circle we draw a wavy line on each side



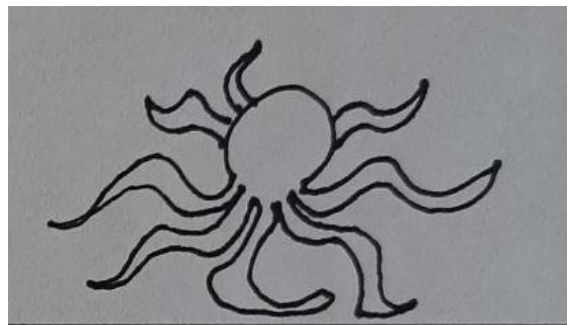
Following the wavy line back we make our 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> leg's



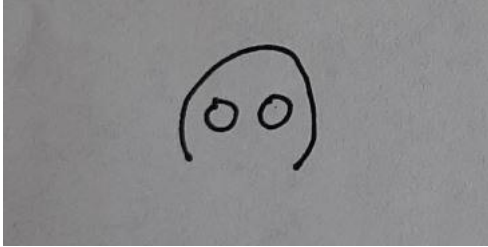
Using the same method we make leg's 3 and 4



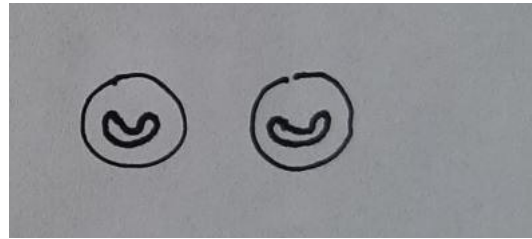
And finally leg number 5



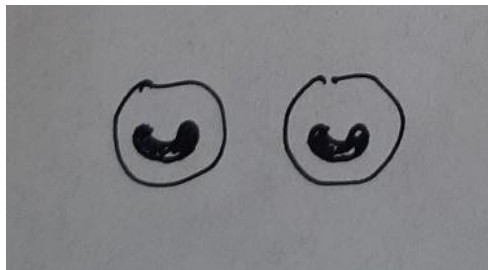
Octopus's have 8 legs but some of them will be behind the body like this



Now lets start on the face, with eye's



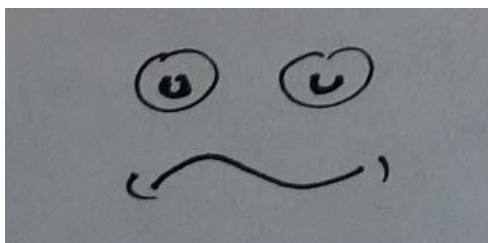
The eye's are circles with a jelly bean shape for the pupils



Fill the pupils in black



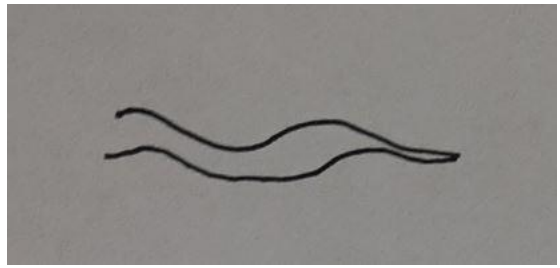
Add a wavy line for the mouth



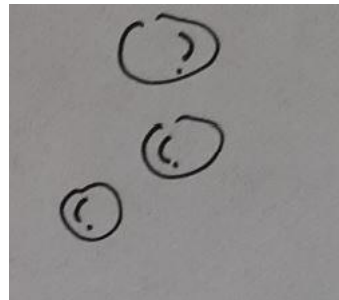
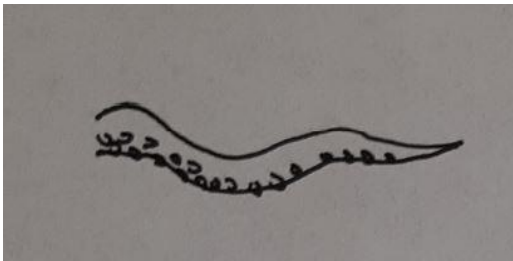
Add a semi circle at each end of the wavy line



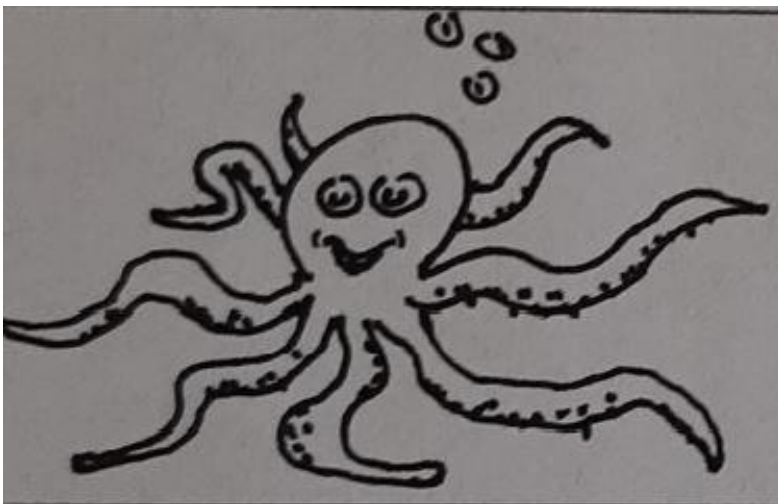
Now add a semi circle to the wavy line and fill it in black to finish the mouth



**Nearly finished but we can add more detail to the legs**



**Small circles can add suckers to the octopus's leg's and air bubbles add life to the drawing**
