

Bicycle Treasure Hunt

This activity invites students to find different parts of the bicycle as part of a treasure hunt in the school yard. This could also be used as an activity in a local park following a fun cycle. Instructions are provided in English but all student worksheets are in Irish.


- Bicycle treasure hunt flash cards
- Group checklist
- Scissors and a hole puncher
- Piece of string
- Laminator
- Prizes (ask your travel officer)



Flashcards

How it works

1. Decide on a location for your treasure hunt. This could be in your school yard, a local park or anywhere it is safe for your students to explore.
2. Cut out and laminate the flashcards provided. They come in sets of four but if you would like them to be smaller just print to two pages. A 'punch hole' is provided at the top of each card so you can tie them up with string and remove them without littering.
3. Strategically place the cards in your chosen location for students to find. Don't make it too easy!
4. Divide your class into groups and provide them with the treasure hunt checklist.
5. Allocate a set amount of time for them to find them all.
