

Green-Schools Marine Spatial Planning Competition

Entry Rules/Competition Terms and Conditions:

- **Theme:** All entries should be designed around the competition theme: **“Our Ocean and My Community – Our Marine Plan”**.
- **Eligibility:** This competition is open to registered Green-Schools who are currently working on, or have been awarded the Green Flag for, the Global Citizenship Marine Environment theme. The submitted entry must not have been/be entered into other art competitions in 2019, 2020 or 2021.
- **Permissions:** All entrants must have the permission of a parent/guardian to enter. The entrant confirms that any person depicted in the entry has granted permission to be portrayed as shown.
- **Copyright:** The artwork submitted must be original and created entirely by the entrant. Any copied, traced or plagiarised work will be disqualified.
- **Closing Date:** Entries must be received at the above address by **4pm, Friday 10th December 2021**.
- **Judging:** A panel of judges will select the winning entries. The Judging Panel is responsible for the allocation of awards and the decision of the Judging Panel is final and no correspondence will be entered into regarding that decision.
- **Notification:** Winners will be notified by email.
- **Returns:** Green-Schools is unable to return any entries to schools.
- **Publicity:** Winners may be asked to take part in competition publicity including being photographed by the media. Photographs of the winners will never be shared publicly without specific consent from the parents or guardians.

Poster Competition:

- **Categories:**
 - Infants (Junior- Senior Infants)
 - Junior Primary (1st- 3rd class)
 - Senior Primary (4th-6th class)
 - Secondary School (1st- 6th Year)
- **Number of Entries:** Individuals can enter **one poster** only but may also enter as part of a group in the 3D model competition.
- **Poster Size:** Posters must be single-sided and **A3** in size.
- **Personal Details:** All **poster competition** entries must include the following information **printed clearly on the reverse of each poster:** a. Student’s Name; b. Class; c. Name and address of School.
- **School’s Details:** Entries should be accompanied by contact details for the Green-Schools coordinator (name, phone number and email address) for correspondence purposes.
- **Postal Address:** Entries should be submitted by post to the following address: *Green-Schools Marine Spatial Planning Competition, An Taisce EEU, 5a Swift’s Alley, Francis St, Dublin 8, D08TN88.*
- **Prizes:**
 - 1st place winners: Art workshop for class, framed poster and a €150 One4all voucher
 - 2nd place: Framed poster and a €100 One4all voucher
 - 3rd place: Framed poster €50 one-4-all voucher
- Prizes are non-transferrable.

3D Model Competition:

- Categories:
 - Primary School Group
 - Secondary School Group
- Number of Entries: One 3D model is permitted per group. Individuals entering the Group 3D Model competition may also enter the poster competition as an individual.
- 3D Model Submissions: Any materials may be used for creating the 3D model, though upcycling is strongly encouraged. The completed model should **not** be posted to Green-Schools. **Please submit up to three high quality photographs of the model** clearly showing a full overview of the model, as well as any important features to **cdevlin@eeu.antaisce.org**.
- Contact Details: All 3D Model competition entries must include the following information **in the body of the email containing the entry photo(s)**: a. Names of Students in the Group b. Class/Year; c. Name and address of School and d) contact details for the Green-Schools coordinator (name, phone number and email address) for correspondence purposes.
- Prizes: 3d model competition prizes:
 - 1st place winners: Art workshop for class and a €200 one-4-all voucher for art supplies, books and/or Green-Schools activities.
 - 2nd place: €150 one-4-all voucher for art supplies, books and/or Green-Schools activities
 - 3rd place: €100 one-4-all voucher art supplies, books and/or Green-Schools activities
- Prizes are non-transferrable.

The rules of the competition may not be changed or modified and will be strictly applied. Entry to the competition constitutes full and unconditional acceptance of these Terms & Conditions.
