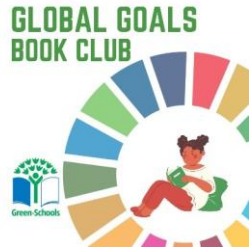


I Dissent: Ruth Bader Ginsburg Makes Her Mark

Justice Scales Activity Sheet

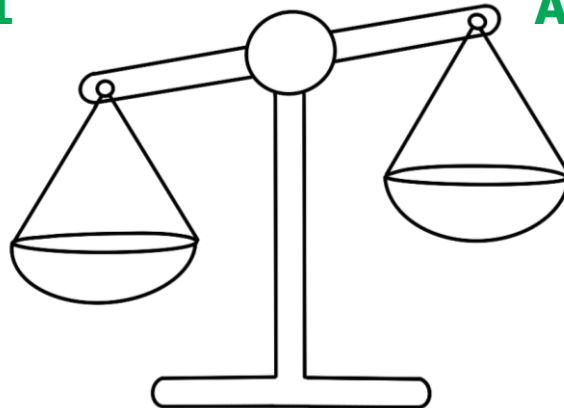

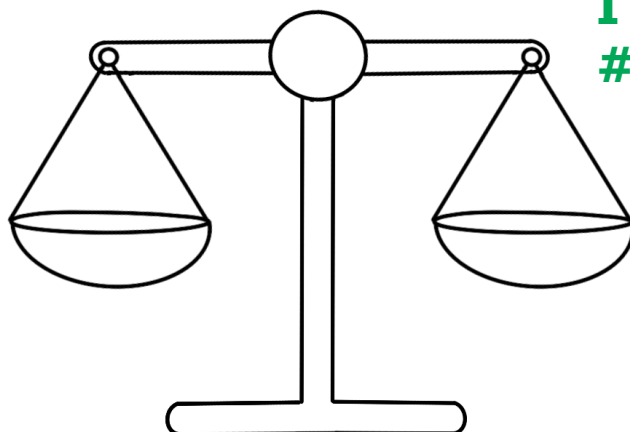
