Swallows have started to arrive in Ireland for the summer. See them swooping through the skies feeding on insects!



Cow Parsley can grow up to 1m tall and is found around the country!



The Small Tortoiseshell Butterfly may be spotted on warm days in April.



Wild Garlic is now in bloom! Little white flowers make this delicious plant stand out!



Herb Robert is a little pink/purple flower that appears in April. It grows on banks, walls and shady places.



Holly Blue Butterfly is about the same size as the Small Tortoiseshell and is found in woodlands and gardens.
