#### **Outline**

This activity invites students to find different parts of the bicycle as part of a treasure hunt in the school yard. This could also be used as an activity in a local park following a fun cycle. Flashcards are provided in Irish with the English translation beneath.

- Piece of string
- Laminator

#### **How it works**

- Decide on a location for your treasure hunt.
   This could be in your school yard, a local park or anywhere it is safe for your students to explore.
- 2. Cut out and laminate the flashcards provided. They come in sets of four but if you would like them to be smaller just print to two pages. A 'punch hole' is provided at the top of each card so you can tie them up with string and remove them without littering.
- 3. Strategically place the cards in your chosen location for students to find. Don't make it too easy!
- 4. Divide your class into groups and provide them with the treasure hunt checklist.
- 5. Allocate a set amount of time for them to find them all.
