Composting is a Biological process that needs organic waste, water and air. Composting involves a wide variety of organicism naturally present in our environment.

Top Layer: contains you fresh organic waste

1st Lever of Consumers: Snails, bacteria, worms, fungi and woodlice.

2nd Level Consumers: Mites, Rotifera, Springtails and ringworms.

3rd Level Consumers: Ants, rove beetles, and centipedes

What Can we put into are compost:



grass clippings, weeds, leaves, plants, cut flowers, cooked or uncooked veg, fruit & peels, tea, coffee, grains, and cereals, twigs, hedge clippings, paper (cut up, in small amounts)
