



## HOW TO INSTALL A KIPPO BAG

## **WORK OUT WATER VOLUME USED FOR TOILET FLUSHING:**

- Work out the volume of the toilet cisterns, it may be printed on the side of the cistern; if not you will need a crayon and one or two plastic measuring jugs.
- With a Crayon, mark the level of the water in the cistern.
- Empty the cistern by flushing the toilet, while holding onto the float ball so that the cistern doesn't fill up again.
- Still holding the float ball, get the students to measure water into the cistern using a measuring jug. Fill the cistern up to the crayon mark.
- Record the number of litres needed to fill the cistern up again- this is your volume of water per flush.

## **INSTALLING THE HIPPO BAG**

Fitting your Hippo is very straightforward. It can be completed in minutes, requiring no tools or expertise.

- 1. Remove the lid from your cistern. Put both hands inside the Hippo and push out the corners to a box shape.
- 2. Place the open end of the Hippo over the cistern float.
- 3. Turn the Hippo under the float and immerse it in water.
- 4. Flush the toilet in the normal manner while simultaneously pouring about 4 litres of water into your Hippo.
- 5. Replace the lid of the cistern and start saving water!

**NB** Make sure the hippo does not obstruct the filling mechanism in the toilet.
