

November - Nature Spotter Sheet



Ivy blossoms already pollinated by insects, begin to swell, on the way to become berries



Leaf litter accumulates at this time of year.
As it decomposes it will return valuable nutrients to the soil for next year's growth.



Explore the bare bark of tree trunks, branches and twigs to find <u>lichens</u>



Watch the evening skies for flocks of crows (Jackdaws and Rooks most commonly) en route to their communal winter roost sites



Closely observe fallen leaves; the colours, patterns, and shapes might inspire artistry!



The seed heads from some flowering plants are in their final days of dropping their seeds, e.g. these Greater Plantain
