

# November - Nature Spotter Sheet



Ivy blossoms already pollinated by insects, begin to swell, on the way to become berries



Explore the bare bark of tree trunks, branches and twigs to find [lichens](#)



Closely observe fallen leaves; the colours, patterns, and shapes might inspire artistry!



Leaf litter accumulates at this time of year. As it decomposes it will return valuable nutrients to the soil for next year's growth.



Watch the evening skies for flocks of crows (Jackdaws and Rooks most commonly) en route to their communal winter roost sites



The seed heads from some flowering plants are in their final days of dropping their seeds, e.g. these Greater Plantain
