'Front of school' treatments, which improve access and alleviate congestion, improve safety for everyone on the journey to school and at the school gate.

By improving access routes to school and providing walking and cycling infrastructure, students and families are supported to travel actively to school.

Cycle parking will be made available for schools on the programme. By providing a secure place to park bikes, more students will have an increased opportunity to cycle to school.

Schools have a dedicated SRTS Infrastructure Officer who will coordinate the programme and will work with local authorities to deliver active travel infrastructure and improve safe access to schools.

By reducing the presence of cars at school gates, children can travel to school actively, safely and independently, with less exposure to poorer air quality.

Children will benefit from a safe and healthy public space to access school. By providing space for walking and cycling, communities can enjoy cleaner air, safer streets, and more vibrant and inclusive public spaces.
