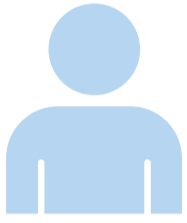

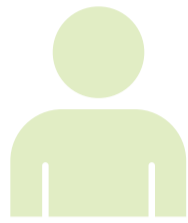

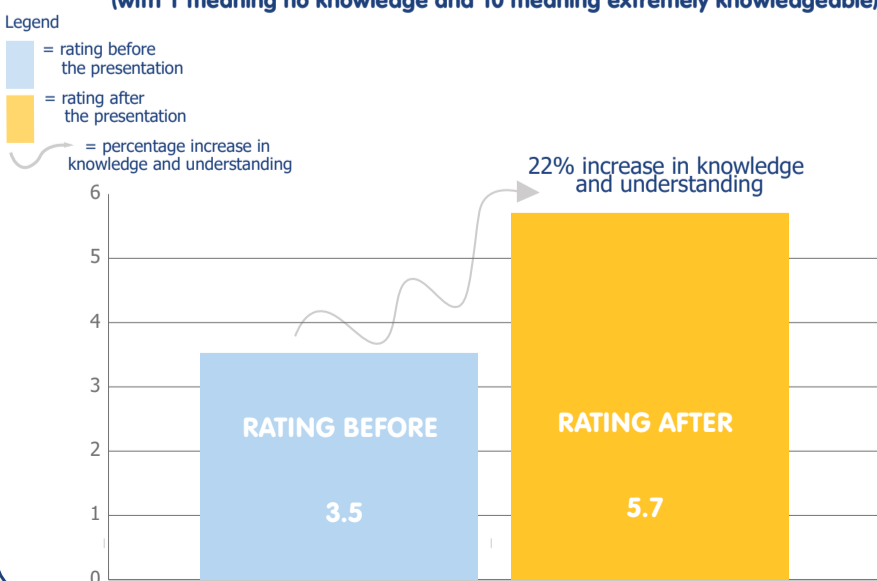

### Teacher Seminar survey

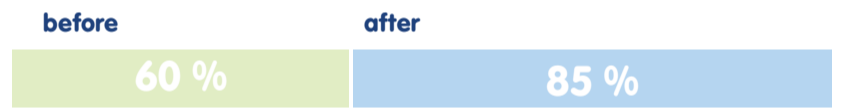

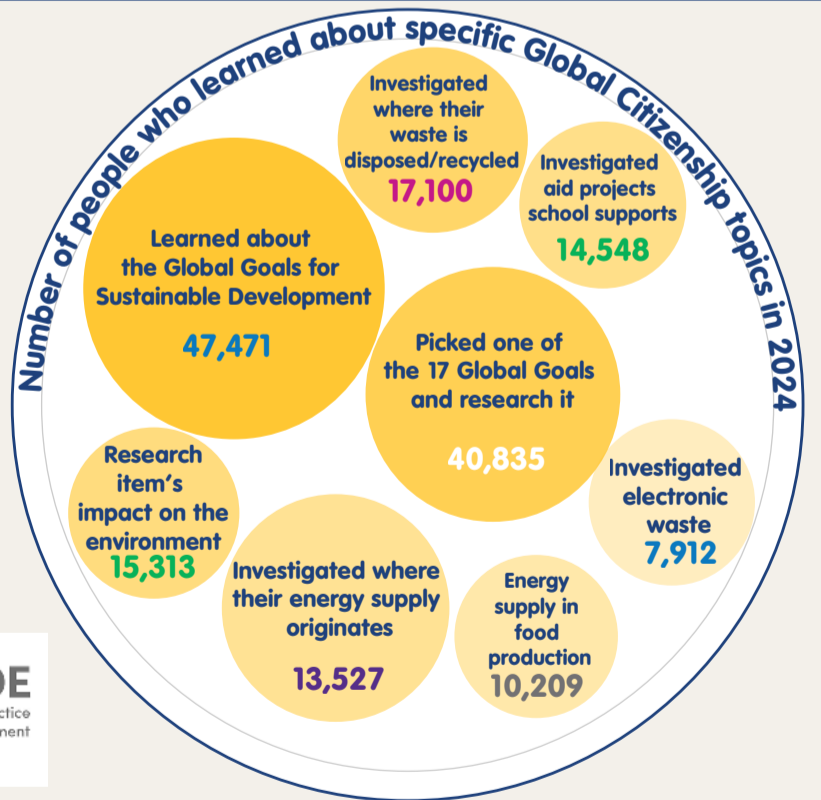
