These stories educate and empower young people to take action for a healthier planet.

Millie McCarthy is a Complete Catastrophe

Read or listen to the book 'Millie McCarthy is a Complete Catastrophe' by Leona Forde with your class. The questions below offer a guide for discussion with your class, along with some actions and activities to complete.

Discussion Questions:

- 1. How does Millie McCarthy's behaviour impact her surroundings and the environment? Can you find examples where her actions have positive or negative effects?
- 2. When Millie encounters a problem, does she think about how her solution might affect the environment? How could she consider climate action in her decisions?
- 3. Are there any moments in the story where Millie learns about the importance of taking care of the environment? What does she learn and how does it change her actions?
- 4. Do any of the other characters in the book talk about climate change or taking care of the environment? What do they say and how does Millie respond?
- 5. Think about a "catastrophe" caused by Millie. How could she have handled it differently to be more environmentally friendly?
- 6. How do the events in the story connect to the idea of climate action? Can you identify any parts of the story that highlight the importance of protecting our planet?
- 7. How can you apply what Millie learns about taking care of the environment to your own life? Can you think of any actions you can take at home or school to help fight climate change?
- 8. Imagine Millie has another chance to create a school project about climate action. What ideas could she come up with to help her classmates understand the importance of taking care of the environment?
- 9. If Millie were to set a goal for reducing her environmental footprint, what steps could she take? How can she inspire others to join her in taking climate action?
- 10. As a class, discuss some of the "catastrophes" Millie faces. What could she and her friends do to help mitigate these problems in a way that supports climate action?
- 11. Do you think it's important for stories like Millie's to include messages about climate action? Why or why not?
- 12. Pretend you are Millie's friend giving her advice on how to be more environmentally conscious. What tips would you give her?

Summary of book

Activity - Help Millie Achieve her Green-Flag

- 1. Read 'Millie McCarthy is a Complete Catastrophe' if you have time in your class, alternatively read the short summary above, or if you have a student that has read the book, it could be nice to ask them to share their thoughts on the book with your class.
- 2. Reflect on the book Millie McCarthy is a Complete Catastrophe with your students what did they think? Like your students, Millie is determined to achieve her Green-Flag and take action on Climate Change (Global Goal 13)
- 3. Ask your students two questions: "Is there anything Millie's class were doing to achieve their flag that you are doing in your school?" and "If you could help Millie to achieve her Flag, what would you do?"
- 4. Invite your students to draw a poster showing the 'perfect school' that they would help Millie to achieve. The school should be committed to environmental sustainability and will make sure that Millie and her friends will achieve their Green Flag! Make sure to showcase which of the Global Goals that they will be taking action on too (it doesn't have to be just Climate Action, for example if their perfect school involves holding swap shops, they can highlight Global Goal 12: Responsible Consumption and Production etc.)!




Hiya, it's Milly! Múinteoir Emer is always giving us fun things to do in school to help us learn. Now you can follow along with me!






ALL ABOUT THE ENVIRONMENT
