


## Get to Know Your Bicycle!



## Across

- 3. This is another name for a bicycle.
- 4. This is usually attached near your breaks and can make a loud noise to alert the pedestrians and cars around you that you are coming!
- 6. This is where you sit, make sure its not too high or too low, it can easily be adjusted to the perfect height.
- **9**. This attaches your pedals to the back wheel and can be cleaned with an old toothbrush.
- 10. These are the wire sticks in your wheels that help your tyre keep its shape.

## Down

- I. You change these when you are going up a hill to make it easier and looks like metal discs with teeth.
- 2. This is a red light on the back of your bicycle.
- 5. This is where you put your feet and gets your bicycle moving when moved in a circle motion.
- 7. This is the hoop portion on the inside of your wheel, make sure it's not bent!
- 8. The part of the bicycle that holds the front wheel.
