- Students and their coordinator showed excellent leadership, speaking confidently about their work on water conservation and maintaining the Water Flag.
- They reduced daily water use from 17 to 16 litres per person. Class 4 led a 'Will it Flush?' experiment as part of the 3 P's campaign, highlighting the impact of flushing non-biodegradable items.
- For their Walk for Water, the school explored global water scarcity through presentations and videos. Senior students completed a 6km walk carrying weighted backpacks, while junior classes walked schoolyard loops with lighter loads to simulate water collection.
- Students also studied aquatic life during a National Parks and Wildlife Service workshop in Knocksink Woods.
