The Green-Schools programme is run on a national basis and supports schools in developing a culture of sustainability across a range of environmental themes. More than 90% of schools in Ireland take part in the programme.

An Taisce is currently seeking a **Green-Schools Officer, based in Munster, to support the Water and Energy themes within a dynamic team.** The post will be full-time at 32.75 hours per week, but a degree of flexibility of working hours around evenings and weekends will be expected.

Key responsibilities:

- Organise and facilitate student training and events
- Train and support teachers with the implementation of the Water and Energy themes at their school
- Develop educational resources for primary and secondary schools
- Develop opportunities for collaborations, internally and externally
- Carry out Green Flag renewal visits to schools where required
- Review and assess Green-Schools application forms for the Green Flag award
- Assist with reporting including preparation of end of year report
- Support programme administration
- Undertake any other such relevant duties as may from time to time arise and are considered appropriate
